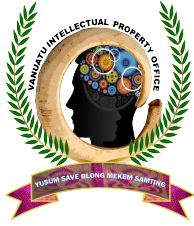
The registrar may , on application of any person , by order in writing revoke a patent on the following grounds  
(Please tick a box or all )

S39(1)(a) – The invention is not a patentable invention; or

S39(1)(b) – The patent was granted to a person who was not entitled to be granted that patent; or  
s39(4)(a) - (found by the court in an action for a declaration); or  
s39(4) (b) – (found by the court or the registrar on a reference under the Vanuatu Patents Act No:2 of 2003)

S39(1)(c) – The specification of the patent does not disclose the invention clearly and completely for it to be performed by a person skill in the art; or

S39(1)(d) – The matter disclosed in the specification of the patent extends beyond that disclosed in the application for the patent as filed



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S39(1)(e) – The protection conferred by the patent has been extended by an amendment which should not have been allowed

S39(1)(f)(ii) – The applicant for a patent has failed to tell the registrar about any corresponding international application filed by the applicant, as required by section 17; or

S39(1)(f)(ii) - The applicant for a patent has given the registrar information that is false in a material Particular.
